SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

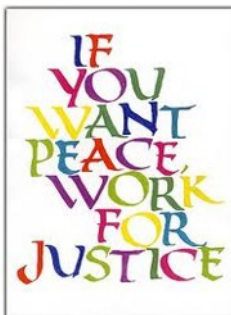

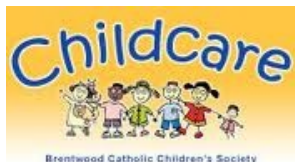
