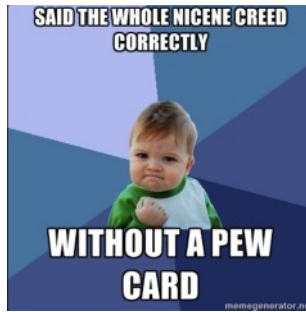

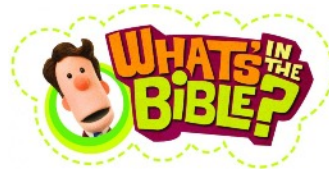
**Friends of Essex Churches Trust** invite you to participate in
